
DHS&EM OPERATIONS

There is a blizzard warning in effect for St. Lawrence Island until 6 pm Tuesday, and northwestern Alaska until 6 am Wednesday.

A coastal flood warning, beginning Tuesday afternoon, has been issued for the southern Seward Peninsula and eastern Norton Sound.

A winter storm watch, beginning Tuesday morning, has been issued for the northeastern Brooks Range. There are multiple gale, small craft, and freezing spray warnings throughout Alaskan waters today. A winter weather advisory, beginning this evening, has been issued for Southeast Alaska.
