


Stebbins Potential Storm Impacts November 21st – 22nd 2017




- Coastal Flood Warning from Tuesday afternoon (Nov 21) through noon Wednesday (Nov 22).
- Combined storm surge and tides of 9 to 11 feet. Water levels will be 2 to 3 feet higher than the Nov 11-12 event.
 - Low lying areas will likely be inundated, including near the first row of homes on the lagoon side of town.
 - Wave run-up will push water higher than storm surge on beach side of town
- Storm surge will increase Tuesday evening and remain high through Wednesday morning. Highest water levels are expected with the high tide around midnight Tue night/Wed morning.
- SOUTHEAST winds becoming WEST 20 to 30 mph Tuesday evening.
