DHS&EM OPERATIONS


The SEOC is at preparedness level 2 for potential coastal storm surge along the west coast of Alaska.

The blizzard warning for northwestern Alaska expires at noon today.

The blizzard and coastal flood warnings for St. Lawrence Island, Seward Peninsula, Norton Sound, and Yukon Delta communities remain in effect until 6 am Thursday.

A high wind warning is in effect for the Aleutians East Borough until 6 pm Thursday.

There is a winter weather advisory and coastal flood advisory for the Lake and Peninsula Borough and the Kuskokwim Delta today.
