

# Benefits of AmeriCorps VISTA



#### **Living Allowance**

Receive a modest bi-weekly living allowance to cover basic expenses.



### Non-Competitive Eligibility (NCE)

NCE is a unique hiring path which makes it easier for federal agencies to hire you.



#### **Relocation Allowance**

Receive relocation travel assistance and a settling-in allowance if you move 50-plus miles from your home.



#### **Professional Development Training**

Attend in-person and virtual professional development opportunities throughout the year.



#### **End of Service Award**

Choose between a Segal Education Award (\$5,920) to pay for a range of education expenses or a cash stipend (\$1,800).



### **Child Care**

You may be eligible to receive up to \$400/month for child care if you have children under the age of 13.



#### **Health Care Benefit**

Enroll in either health care reimbursement or a health care plan. Dental, vision and telehealth services are also included.

## Who Can Apply

AmeriCorps VISTA service is open to people over the age of 18 and are a U.S. Citizen, U.S. National, Lawful Permanent Resident Alien or are a person legally residing in a state that has one of the following legal residency classifications: refugee, asylum or asylee, or temporary protected status.

2. Search ANTHCOpportunities



Go to <u>my.americorps.gov</u>, click "Search Listings" and enter the following into the Quick Search:

3. Apply



Find the AmeriCorps project that is right for you and submit an application. Note: you may also be considered for other ANTHC opportunity listings without reapplying.

4. Interview



If selected by the project, you'll be contacted for an interview.

5. Begin Service



If you are selected for the project you will attend training and begin your year of service.
